**Sawyer PointOne Units** are proven in disaster relief for the treatment of cholera. These simple units work by gravity and are back-washable. Each unit treats ~287 US gallons per day. Sawyer has partnered in the cause, offering CaribDA members a discounted rate and warehousing to consolidate shipping.

PADF will manage CaribDA member donations that will be specifically earmarked for the purchase of Sawyer Units & 5 gallon buckets (manufactured in Haiti by PlasTech Industries in Haiti).

CaribDA's goal is for our membership is to provide 1000 units. Each kit is \$45.00.
