# DOMINICA 2017

## The Need:

The passage of Hurricane Maria resulted in loss or damage to 80% of the buildings on Dominica and severely damaged power and water supplies. Princess Margaret hospital was damaged and reduced from 250 to 100 beds and was left without running water.

## How We Helped:

CaribDA in cooperation with other institutions helped to identify and implement solutions for the most immediate needs

Our members donated two (2) 3,000 gpd UF units, assisted in an Installation at the Princess Margaret Hospital and trained hospital staff on the operation and maintenance of the units.

Other ancillary equipment (intake pump for the river, intake screens, storage and transfer tanks, etc.) was supplied for the installation of the second UF unit in the rural community of Londonderry, where feed water had to be drawn from a river.
