The Need:

Improving potable water quality in the aftermath of Hurricane Mathew in Haiti

How we helped:

A total of U\$7,075 was raised for the Haiti effort through the PADF donation portal

100% of the funds raised went directly to purchase 272 Sawyer kits and Two 5 gal buckets.

These kits were distributed by PADF to 75 schools, serving over 14,000 children and their families in the hardest hit areas of Haiti.

CaribDA HC volunteers traveled to Haiti to train PADF’s community representatives (engineers, scientists, social workers, etc.) in the correct use of the kits to ensure maximum effectiveness and long life.
